LIVING WILLS & HEALTH CARE POWER OF ATTORNEY A living will is a legal document that allows you to make prior decisions about whether your life should be prolonged by certain medical procedures. A **health care power of attorney** is a legal document in which you give someone power to make medical decisions for you if you are not competent or if you are unable to communicate.

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



